CHRIST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH COVID-19 VOLUNTEER/PARTICIPANT POLICIES

As our wonderfully dedicated volunteers and program participants begin serving in the community and at Christ United, and participate in Christ United programs at Christ United and off-site, these policies must be followed to ensure you feel safe and secure as we navigate the complexities of our "new normal". The safety and well-being of our staff, visitors, and volunteers is top priority. These policies are intended to follow guidance from the CDC, and state and local governmental agencies.

DO NOT VOLUNTEER OR PARTICPATE IF YOU

- are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19:
- have tested positive for or been diagnosed with COVID-19:
- live with someone who, in the past 14 days has been diagnosed or tested positive for COVID-19 or displayed symptoms; or
- have come into direct contact in the past 14 days with someone who has tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19.

REPORTING PROCEDURE

If you have volunteered and/or participated in a Christ United activity/program and are diagnosed with and/or tested positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed with and/or tested positive for COVID-19, you must immediately notify Kim Hill by email at kim@cumc.com.

Your identity will remain anonymous as we notify those with potential exposure.

REQUIREMENTS FOR VOLUNTEERING AND PARTICIPATION

- Take your temperature immediately before volunteering/participating. If your temperature is above 99.00 degrees, you may not participate in the activity/program. If your temperature is above 99.0 degrees, you may not participate in the activity/program. Christ United staff may also be checking temperature of volunteer/participant at various times. Individuals who arrive on-site with symptoms will be sent home.
- Wash your hands often, and for the recommended 20 seconds.
- Stay at least 6 feet apart at all times where possible.
- You must wear a mask when volunteering/participating unless the program director has been given special permission by Christ United's Director of Operations to not wear a mask. In that case volunteers/participants must remain 6 feet apart at all times.
- Please take all necessary precautions if you are immunocompromised or live with/care for someone who is immunocompromised.

- Mission work at residential sites should be limited to outside work only at this time and in small groups (less than 10 people) with limited client contact.
- Planning and discussions for mission projects should be done either by telephone, video conference, e-mail, or if in person small groups (less than 10) while practicing social distancing (keeping 6 feet between themselves and others).
- Participants in mission projects should wear a facemask when they have to go out in public and while serving in our community. The facemask is not a substitute for social distancing.
- Preparation or sharing of food is prohibited. Note that the communal kitchen and adjacent meeting rooms in the Sports and Recreation Center are closed until further notice.
- Mission work teams may optionally meet for a meal while continuing to maintain safe practices.

CHRIST UNITED FACILITIES:

- More frequent cleaning and sanitizing of Christ United facilities.
- Access to hand sanitizer throughout the building.
- Extensive signage warning those with symptoms to not enter the building, and encouraging frequent handwashing, social distancing and masks.
